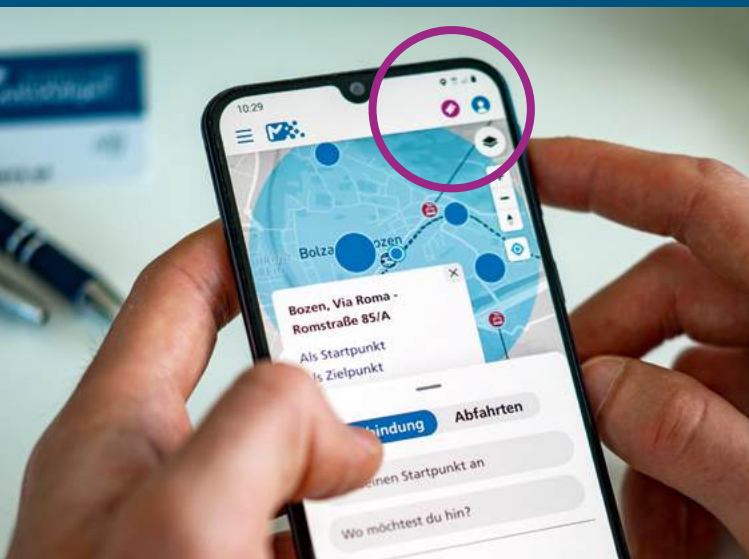


Mobile ticketing

Buy your ticket online



Your one-stop-shop: Buy your ticket online and check in using the südtirolmobil app!

Which online tickets can I buy?

- single tickets for selected routes
- inner-city day passes for Bozen/Bolzano or Meran/Merano
- Mobilcards for 1, 3 or 7 days
- tickets for the Ritten/Renon cable car and light railway
- tickets for the Kohlern/Colle cable car
- Mendel/Mendola funicular
- tickets for Nightliner buses
- tickets for transporting bicycles
- Euregio 2 Plus day passes
- Some tourist tickets

And this is how it works:

1 Get the app



2 Buy your ticket

Select the ticket you'd like to buy. For a single ticket, select the bus or train connection first and then click on **Buy**.

3 Validate your ticket

Go to **Tickets** to find the ticket you have just bought. Before starting your journey, click on **Check in** and use.

Your ticket is now validated and displayed as **Active journey**. Online tickets must be checked in only once before starting the journey.

4 Show your ticket

When boarding a bus or a train, click on the QR-Code icon and show your online ticket in the event of checks.

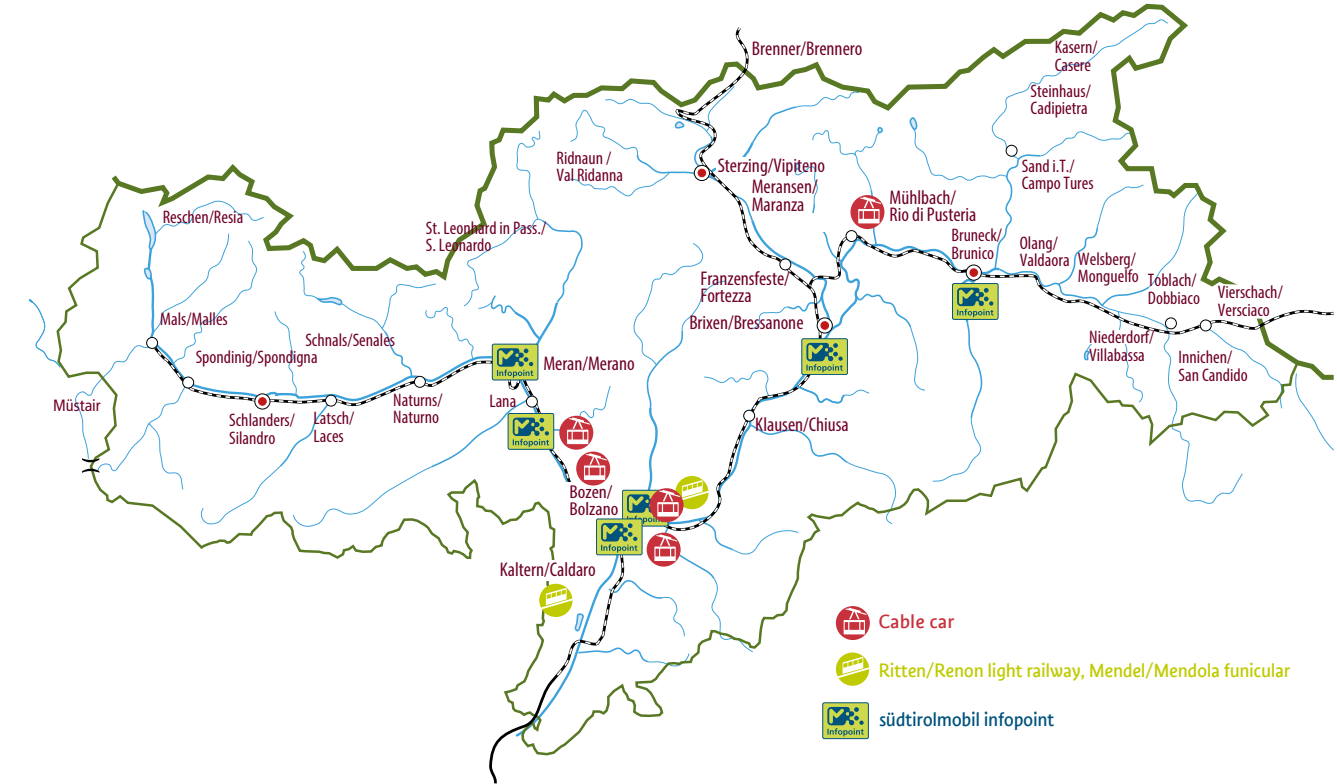

A close-knit network of bus and rail services

The südtirolmobil network includes:

- regional and regional express trains in South Tyrol and all the way to Trento
- regional, urban and Citybus services
- cable-cars to and from Ritten/Ritten, Kohlern/Colle, Mölten/Meltina, Vöran/verano and Meransen/Maranza
- Ritten/Renon light railway
- Mendel/Mendola funicular
- PostAuto Schweiz bus services (811) between Malles/Mals and Müstair in Switzerland
- bus service (273) between Malles/Mals and Pfunds/Kajetansbrücke

Not included: long-distance or high-speed trains and specialist tourist bus services.



Bring your bike

An additional ticket is required for carrying a bicycle on board of public transport.

- Regional trains: bikes are allowed only if space is available (Reservation not possible).
- Regional buses equipped with bicycle racks: check the timetable marked with the bike symbol.



Travelling with a pet

An additional ticket is required for carrying medium- and large-sized dogs on all public transport. Dogs must be kept on a lead at all times and must wear a muzzle.



Little Travellers

Children up to the age of 6 travel for free and do not need a ticket.

Good to know

For the transport of bikes and animals on the cable cars of Kohlern/Colle, Mölten/Meltina, Vöran/Verano, and Meransen/Maranza, it is possible to purchase tickets directly on-site at a special fare.
